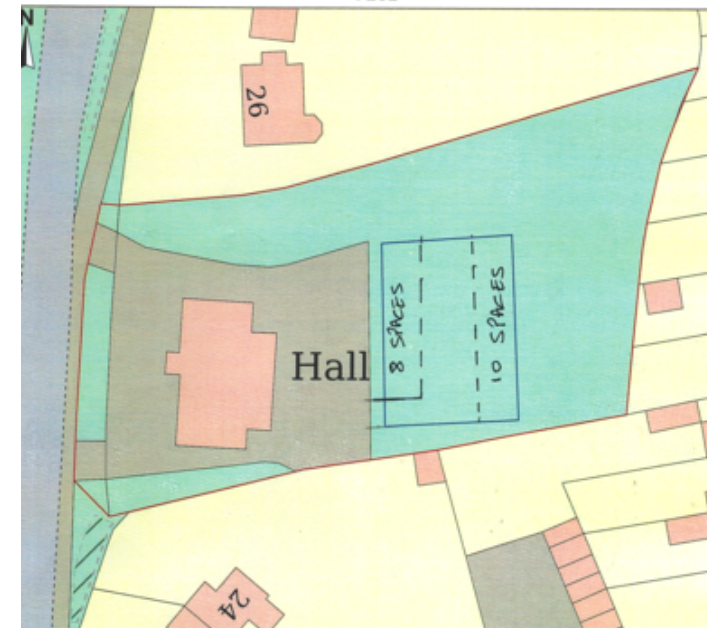


Village Hall Car Park Extension
